Our passage today is from Psalm 24. As you prepare your heart for worship in song, in His Word, and in the fellowship of the saints, please consider:

COMPLEMENTARY SCRIPTURE

“He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him. And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together. And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent. For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.”

[Colossians 1:15-20 ESV]

CONSIDER - DISCUSS - PRAY

- Think about God as Creator - what does that mean for his ownership over all the Earth? Is this widely accepted?
- What does it mean in Romans 3:10-11 that no one is righteous? How do we balance that with the access to God we have in Jesus?
- What ways did [is] God use [using] to draw you to Himself?
- What does Hebrews 11:6 mean that God is a “rewarder of those who seek Him?”
- Look at the passage above from Colossians - summarize this in your own words and list at least one truth that struck you about Jesus.
