- Response None of this is effective for us unless we respond in two ways: <u>repent/turn</u> from our self control and sin [Mark 1:15], and <u>believe</u> in the gospel [John 3:16-18]. We are then given new life in Christ, forgiven, justified, adopted into God's family, and we persevere in the faith. [1 John 1:9; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Matthew 24:13; Ephesians 4:1]

CONSIDER - DISCUSS - PRAY

- Paul is in prison but calls himself a "prisoner of Christ" What would it look like for us to be prisoners for the gospel? Read Phil 1, vs 13 and Eph 3 vs 1. Discuss Romans 8 vs 28 in light of the above.
- What should be the primary mark of a Christian? Some scriptures to look at: Col 3 vs 13, Eph 4 vs 32, Mark 11 vs 25, Luke 17 vs 4
- What does Philemon vs 17-19 depict?
- In Philemon, vs 10 & 11, Paul sends back Onesimus to Philemon. Discuss how both may have felt over this.
- What good things does our forgiveness promote?
