You will hear us talk about the gospel a lot. Actually it is the center of everything we do here at Highlands.

- 1. **God** the only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]
- 2. **Sin -** Yet, we rejected God, and established ourselves as gods of our lives, separating ourselves from Him, and becoming objects of His wrath. In so doing we also unleashed sin, sickness, death and evil. [Ephesians 2:1-3; Romans 5:12-14]
- 3. Christ In God's unparalleled mercy and grace, He already had a plan to reconcile us to Himself. The entire Old Testament points to the coming of the Messiah revealed in the New Testament as Jesus Christ. [John 1; Ephesians 2:4-7; Romans 3:21-26]
- 4. Response None of this is effective for us unless we respond in two ways: <u>repent/turn</u> from our self control and sin [Mark 1:15], and <u>believe</u> in the gospel [John 3:16-18]. We are then given new life in Christ, forgiven, justified, adopted into God's family, and we persevere in the faith. [1 John 1:9; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Matthew 24:13; Ephesians 4:1]

COMPLEMENTARY SCRIPTURE

"...you yourselves know what happened throughout all Judea, beginning from Galilee after the baptism that John proclaimed: how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him."

(Acts 10:37-38 ESV)

CONSIDER - DISCUSS - PRAY

- When you think of "righteousness" what comes to mind? Compare the "church" definition and a more "secular" definition. What are the differences?
- Review 2 Cor 5:21, 1 Peter 3:18, and Romans 8:3-4 one at a time.
 What things resonate with you? Which words are sweetest and why?
- Consider the work of the Holy Spirit. What other passages can you think of that describe his work? [Ex.John 3:6-7; Gal 5:18, 25...]
- How have you listened to the Spirit's leading this week? Where do you need to grow in doing that?
- How can we speak hard truths such as "Jesus is the only way to the Father" in gentle and yet compelling ways? Can anyone share an experience where you did this?
