the gospel

You will hear us talk about the gospel a lot. Actually it is the center of everything we do here at Highlands.

1. **God** - the only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]
2. **Sin** - Yet, we rejected God, and established ourselves as gods of our lives, separating ourselves from Him, and becoming objects of His wrath. In so doing we also unleashed sin, sickness, death and evil. [Ephesians 2:1-3; Romans 5:12-14]
3. **Christ** - In God's unparalleled mercy and grace, He already had a plan to reconcile us to Himself. The entire Old Testament points to the coming of the Messiah - revealed in the New Testament as Jesus Christ. [John 1; Ephesians 2:4-7; Romans 3:21-26]
4. **Response** - None of this is effective for us unless we respond in two ways: repent/turn from our self control and sin [Mark 1:15], and believe in the gospel [John 3:16-18]. We are then given new life in Christ, forgiven, justified, adopted into God's family, and we persevere in the faith. [1 John 1:9; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Matthew 24:13; Ephesians 4:1]

Our sermon passage today is from Matthew 8:1-17. As you prepare your heart for worship in song, in His Word, His table, and in the fellowship of the saints, please consider:

COMPLEMENTARY SCRIPTURE

“He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.”
(1 Peter 2:24 ESV)

CONSIDER - DISCUSS - PRAY

- What is your perspective on the miracles of Jesus? Do you have a hard time believing them? Why? What is the effect of not believing they happened?
- Think about the symbolism of leprosy as being a curse of God and cutting someone off from his people and worship. What comes to mind? How is that changed in Jesus? How are we all “lepers?”
- Look again at these accounts - how can we see the compassion of Jesus in what he does and says to each person?
- Look again at Romans 4:16 - what is the promise he mentions? [hint see Genesis 12:1-2] What other passages speak to the nature of the promise being fulfilled by faith?
- How can you bear witness to Jesus caring for your physical needs but also for your deepest spiritual needs?
