

- Sin Yet, we rejected God, and established ourselves as gods of our lives, separating ourselves from Him, and becoming objects of His wrath. In so doing we also unleashed sin, sickness, death and evil. [Ephesians 2:1-3; Romans 5:12-14]
- 3. Christ In God's unparalleled mercy and grace, He already had a plan to reconcile us to Himself. The entire Old Testament points to the coming of the Messiah revealed in the New Testament as Jesus Christ. [John 1; Ephesians 2:4-7; Romans 3:21-26]
- 4. Response None of this is effective for us unless we respond in two ways: <u>repent/turn</u> from our self control and sin [Mark 1:15], and <u>believe</u> in the gospel [John 3:16-18]. We are then given new life in Christ, forgiven, justified, adopted into God's family, and we persevere in the faith. [1 John 1:9; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Matthew 24:13; Ephesians 4:1]

Advent: A Savior Promised

1. I Saw the Light [9:1-5; Matthew 4:15-16; John 1:4; 1:9; 8:12]

The promised Savior will bring light to the darkness.

2. No Ordinary Baby [9:6; Luke 2:8-14; Hebrews 2:17-18]

The promised Savior will be both God and man.

3. Little Faith [9:7; Revelation 4:8]

The promised Savior will be the King of all the ages.

Big Idea: The promised Savior has come to save.
