the gospel

You will hear us talk about the gospel a lot. Actually it is the center of everything we do here at Highlands.

- 1. **God -** the only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]
- 2. **Sin -** Yet, we rejected God, and established ourselves as gods of our lives, separating ourselves from Him, and becoming objects of His wrath. In so doing we also unleashed sin, sickness, death and evil. [Ephesians 2:1-3; Romans 5:12-14]
- 3. Christ In God's unparalleled mercy and grace, He already had a plan to reconcile us to Himself. The entire Old Testament points to the coming of the Messiah revealed in the New Testament as Jesus Christ. [John 1; Ephesians 2:4-7; Romans 3:21-26]
- 4. Response None of this is effective for us unless we respond in two ways: <u>repent/turn</u> from our self control and sin [Mark 1:15], and <u>believe</u> in the gospel [John 3:16-18]. We are then given new life in Christ, forgiven, justified, adopted into God's family, and we persevere in the faith. [1 John 1:9; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Matthew 24:13; Ephesians 4:1]

COMPLEMENTARY SCRIPTURE

""It was also said, 'Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce.' But I say to you that everyone who divorces his wife, except on the ground of sexual immorality, makes her commit adultery, and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery." — Matthew 5:31–32 ESV

CONSIDER - DISCUSS - PRAY

- What is the prevailing cultural perspective on marriage? Is it valued and honored? What about divorce? Is it rare?
- Review first section in what other passages can we we see the biblical perspective on gender and marriage?
- How does Matthew 18:15-35 relate to marriage conflict and reconciliation? How is the gospel key to reconciliation?
- If you are married, in what specific ways can you show our world how you cherish and honor the marriage covenant?
- If you are single, how can God's word help you balance the hope for a spouse and the potential of remaining single?
- If you are divorced, have you sought forgiveness (if necessary) and healing in the gospel of Jesus?

MATTHEW 19:1-12

Counter Cultural Jesus

1. Three Layered Truth Bomb [19:1-6; Genesis 1:27; 2:24; Malachi 2:15; Ephesians 5:22-33.]

God's will is for the union of a man and a woman in marriage to last forever.

2. The Moses Loophole? [19:7-9; Deuteronomy 24:1-4; Matthew 5:31-32]

God's will does not include divorce, except in very rare circumstances.

3. To Marry or Not? [19:10-12; Psalm 16:4]

God's will could include singleness and that's OK.

Big Idea: God defines gender, marriage, and sexuality - not culture.
