the gospel

You will hear us talk about the gospel a lot. Actually it is the center of everything we do here at Highlands.

- God the only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]
- 2. **Sin -** Yet, we rejected God, and established ourselves as gods of our lives, separating ourselves from Him, and becoming objects of His wrath. In so doing we also unleashed sin, sickness, death and evil. [Ephesians 2:1-3; Romans 5:12-14]
- 3. **Christ -** In God's unparalleled mercy and grace, He already had a plan to reconcile us to Himself. The entire Old Testament points to the coming of the Messiah revealed in the New Testament as Jesus Christ. [John 1; Ephesians 2:4-7; Romans 3:21-26]
- 4. Response None of this is effective for us unless we respond in two ways: <u>repent/turn</u> from our self control and sin [Mark 1:15], and <u>believe</u> in the gospel [John 3:16-18]. We are then given new life in Christ, forgiven, justified, adopted into God's family, and we persevere in the faith. [1 John 1:9; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Matthew 24:13; Ephesians 4:1]

3. Vineyard Owner's Prerogative [20:13-16; Psalm 115:3; Ephesians 1:11; Romans 11:36; Ephesians 1:4]

God is sovereign over salvation.
