Responses and Consequences [22:5-7; Isaiah 59:2; 1 John 1:8-10]

Rejecting the Kingdom comes with consequences.

3. Inappropriately Dressed [22:8-14; Philippians 3:9-11]

Entrance into the Kingdom is only through Christ.

Big Idea: Kingdom people are a chosen people.
