#### THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

### COMPLIMENTARY SCRIPTURE

"Then Moses said to God, "If I come to the people of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is his name?' what shall I say to them?" God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And he said, "Say this to the people of Israel: 'I AM has sent me to you." We are to clarify the actual truth of Scripture.
