THE GOSPEL

THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

GOD: The only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]

SIN: Yet, we rejected God, and established ourselves as gods of our lives, separating ourselves from Him, and becoming objects of His wrath. In so doing we also unleashed sin, sickness, death and evil. [Ephesians 2:1-3; Romans 5:12-14]

CHRIST: In God's unparalleled mercy and grace, He already had a plan to reconcile us to Himself. The entire Old Testament points to the coming of the Messiah - revealed in the New Testament as Jesus Christ. [John 1; Ephesians 2:4-7; Romans 3:21-26]

RESPONSE: None of this is effective for us unless we respond in two ways: repent/turn from our self control and sin [Mark 1:15], and believe in the gospel [John 3:16-18]. We are then given new life in Christ, forgiven, justified, adopted into God's family, and we persevere in the faith. [1 John 1:9; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Matthew 24:13; Ephesians 4:1]

SERMON NOTES

MATTHEW 19:16-22 | Defending the Faith - Jesus

1. Intro Matters: Jesus = Greatest Apologist [19:16-22]

Jesus fulfills the prophets. [Luke 4:17-21]

Jesus fulfills the law. [Matthew 5:17; Romans 10:4]

Jesus IS God. [John 4:25-26; 8:58; Mark 14:60-64]

2. Contextualized [v16-19]

Defending the faith involves asking context questions.

3. Compassionate [v20-21; Mark 10:17-22; Matthew 6:36-38; 2 Thessalonians 1:9-10]

Defending the faith involves having compassion for the lost.

4. Compelling [v21-22]

Defending the faith involves speaking the truth and inviting to respond.
