

THE GOSPEL

THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

GOD: The only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]

SIN: Yet, we rejected God, and established ourselves as gods of our lives, separating ourselves from Him, and becoming objects of His wrath. In so doing we also unleashed sin, sickness, death and evil. [Ephesians 2:1-3; Romans 5:12-14]

SERMON NOTES

Luke 1:67-80 Advent Week 3

1. Prophetic Praise [1:67-75; Psalm 132:17; 2 Samuel 22:3 Jeremiah 46:27-28]

Jesus fulfills God's promise of salvation so that we can serve him in holiness.

2. Light and Life [1:76-80; Malachi 4:5-6; Matthew 11:13-15; Romans 5:1]

Jesus fulfills God's promise of renewal so that we can live in peace.

Big Idea: Jesus came to give us holiness and peace.
