THE GOSPEL THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

GOD: The only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]

SERMON NOTES Exodus 20:13 | Do Not Murder

1. Explanation: Commanding and Forbidding [20:13; Genesis 1:25-27; Exodus 22:2]

We are commanded to do whatever leads to life.

2. Application: Violating and Obeying [20:13; Genesis 9:6; Exodus 22:2; Matthew 5:17-20; 21-22; Ephesians 4:26-27; Matthew 5:9; Romans 12:18]

- We don't give into physical violence, but rather promote peace.
- We seek what leads to our own physical health and the health of those around us.
- We strive to help and protect our neighbors instead of isolating ourselves.

Big Idea: We love others by doing all we can to preserve life.
