THE GOSPEL

THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

Exodus 20:16 | Do Not Lie

1. Explanation: Commanding and Forbidding [20:16; Ephesians 4:15, 25; John 8:44]

We are commanded to tell the truth and forbidden from lying.

2. Application: Violating and Obeying [20:16; Psalm 119:160; John 17:17; Jeremiah 17:9]

We violate this commandment by speaking incorrectly, incompletely, or failing to speak at all.

We obey this commandment by speaking truth because we serve the God of truth.

Big Idea: We love others by living lives of truth.
