

THE GOSPEL

THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

GOD: The only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]

SIN: Yet, we rejected God, and established ourselves as gods of our lives, separating ourselves from Him, and becoming objects of His wrath. In so doing we also unleashed sin, sickness, death and evil. [Ephesians 2:1-3; Romans 5:12-14]

CHRIST: In God's unparalleled mercy and grace, He already had a plan to reconcile us to Himself. The entire Old Testament points to the coming of the Messiah - revealed in the New Testament as Jesus Christ. [John 1; Ephesians 2:4-7; Romans 3:21-26]

RESPONSE: None of this is effective for us unless we respond in two ways: repent/turn from our self control and sin [Mark 1:15], and believe in the gospel [John 3:16-18]. We are then given new life in Christ, forgiven, justified, adopted into God's family, and we persevere in the faith. [1 John 1:9; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Matthew 24:13; Ephesians 4:1]

1. Explanation: Commanding and Forbidding [20:17

We are commanded to respect others and their possessions.

- 2. Application: Violating and Obeying [20:17; 2 Corinthians 9:15; Ephesians 5:20; Matthew 5:25-34; Philippians 4:11-13; Romans 7:7-12; 8:1-4]
- We might be coveting if...[Four ways]

 We obey this commandment by cultivating thankfulness, trust, and contentment.

Big Idea: Loving others means not coveting what belongs to them.

Bonus Big Idea: God's law makes us aware of our sin and our need for a Savior.
