SERMON NOTES Romans 4:1-12 | Faith is What Counts

1. Father Abraham [4:1-3; Genesis 12:1-4; 15:1-6; Galatians 3:8; Numbers 23:19]

Justification by faith has always been the plan.

2. King David [4:4-8; Hebrews 11:1; Psalm 32:1-2; Romans 5:6-8]

Justification by faith forgives the unforgivable.

3. Chronological Evidence [4:9-12; Acts 2:21]

Justification by faith justifies all who come to God by faith.

Big Idea: Faith is the only thing that counts for justification.
