Big Idea: Being a Christian means having Jesus as our Master.

1. Know Ye Not, Part 3 [7:1-4; Colossians 2:13-14; Ephesians 2:8-10; Galatians 5:22-24]

When Jesus is our Master, our purpose is fruitfulness.

2. Divine Check Engine Light [7:5-6; Titus 3:5; John 16:7-11; 1 Corinthians 12:4-7]

When Jesus is our Master, the Holy Spirit empowers our new lives.

3. Death and the Law [7:7-12; 3:20; Galatians 5:16-26]

When Jesus is our Master, we love God's Law but are wise as to how sin works.
