SERMON NOTES Romans 8:26-30 | Assurance, Part 3

1. Spiritual Groanings [8:26-27; 2 Corinthians 12:7-10]

Through the Spirit, believers can be confident that our prayers are aligned with God's will.

2. All Things for Good? [8:28; Ephesians 1:3-5]

Believers can be certain that God is working all situations for our good.

3. Unbreakable Chain of Salvation. [8:29-30; Philippians 1:6]

Believers can be sure that God will complete the work he started.

Big Idea: God's sovereignty is our ultimate assurance.
