THE GOSPEL THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

GOD: The only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]

SERMON NOTES Romans 10:14-21 | The Nature of the Gospel

1. Beautiful Feet [10:14-15; Isaiah 52:7; Matthew 28:18-20]

The gospel is a message to be proclaimed to all.

2. The Command of Salvation [10:16-17; Isaiah 53:1; Mark 1:15; Romans 2:8; 2 Thessalonians 1:8; Romans 10:10]

The gospel is a command to be obeyed through belief.
