THE GOSPEL

THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

GOD: The only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]

SERMON NOTES

Romans 11:1-10 | The Remnant and The Rest

1. The Remnant [11:1-6; 1 Kings 18-19; Romans 9:27; 9:16]

Big Idea: God saves a remnant, and it's all by his grace.

2. The Rest [11:7-10; Isaiah 29:9-10; Deuteronomy 29:2-4; Psalm 69:22-23; Romans 9:30-32]

Our sin blinds us to God's grace and God leaves some in their sin as judgment.
