The Mighty, Sovereign Hand of God | O Great God | Jesus, Thank You | The Goodness of Jesus 3. Doxology [11:33-36; Isaiah 40:13; 55:8-9]

God sovereignty in all things is seen ultimately in salvation.

Big Idea: The end goal of salvation is worship.
