THE GOSPEL

THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

1. The Horn [1:1-4; 30-37; 67-69; 2 Samuel 22:2-3; Psalm 18:2-3; 2 Samuel 7:12-13; Exodus 27:1-2]

Jesus is strong enough to save.

Big Idea: Christ's coming provides salvation for his people.
