THE GOSPEL

THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

GOD: The only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]

SIN: Yet, we rejected God, and established ourselves as gods of our lives, separating ourselves from Him, and becoming objects of His wrath. In so doing we also unleashed sin, sickness, death and evil. [Ephesians 2:1-3; Romans 5:12-14]

CHRIST: In God's unparalleled mercy and grace, He already had a plan to reconcile us to Himself. The entire Old Testament points to the coming of the Messiah - revealed in the New Testament as Jesus Christ. [John 1; Ephesians 2:4-7; Romans 3:21-26]

RESPONSE: None of this is effective for us unless we respond in two ways: repent/turn from our self control and sin [Mark 1:15], and believe in the gospel [John 3:16-18]. We are then given new life in Christ, forgiven, justified, adopted into God's family, and we persevere in the faith. [1 John 1:9; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Matthew 24:13; Ephesians 4:1]

- Read Jeremiah 9:23-24. What does it practically mean to boast in the Lord?
- If the church is built on the foundation of Christ - what does that practically mean? What does it look like to have our lives built on the foundation of Christ?

SERMON NOTES

Romans 15:14-21 | What Should the Church Know?

1. I Know You are Good... [15:14; 3:10-12; 1 John 3:17-18; Colossians 1:28; 3:16]

The church knows that it is good to care for one another.

2. ...but just a reminder...[15:15-19; Acts 9:15; Jeremiah 9:23-24]

The church knows that Christ alone transforms lives.

3. And Thus...[15:20-21; Isaiah 52:15; 1 Corinthians 3:10-11; Ephesians 2:19-22]

The church knows that we build on the Apostle’s gospel foundation.

Big Idea: The church must know what we are supposed to be doing.
