

THE GOSPEL

THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

GOD: The only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]

1. A Few Exegetical Hurdles [6:1-8; Numbers 13:31-33; Genesis 5:28-29; John 3:36; Romans 1:18; 5:9; Hebrews 11:7]

God's people realize that we are saved from God's wrath.

2. Noah Contra Mundum [6:9-14; Luke 17:26-27; 2 Peter 2:4-10; John 15:6; Hebrews 6:4-6]

God's people take God's warnings seriously.

3. Command to Construction [6:15-22; John 14:15; 2 John 6]

God's people obey God's commands.
