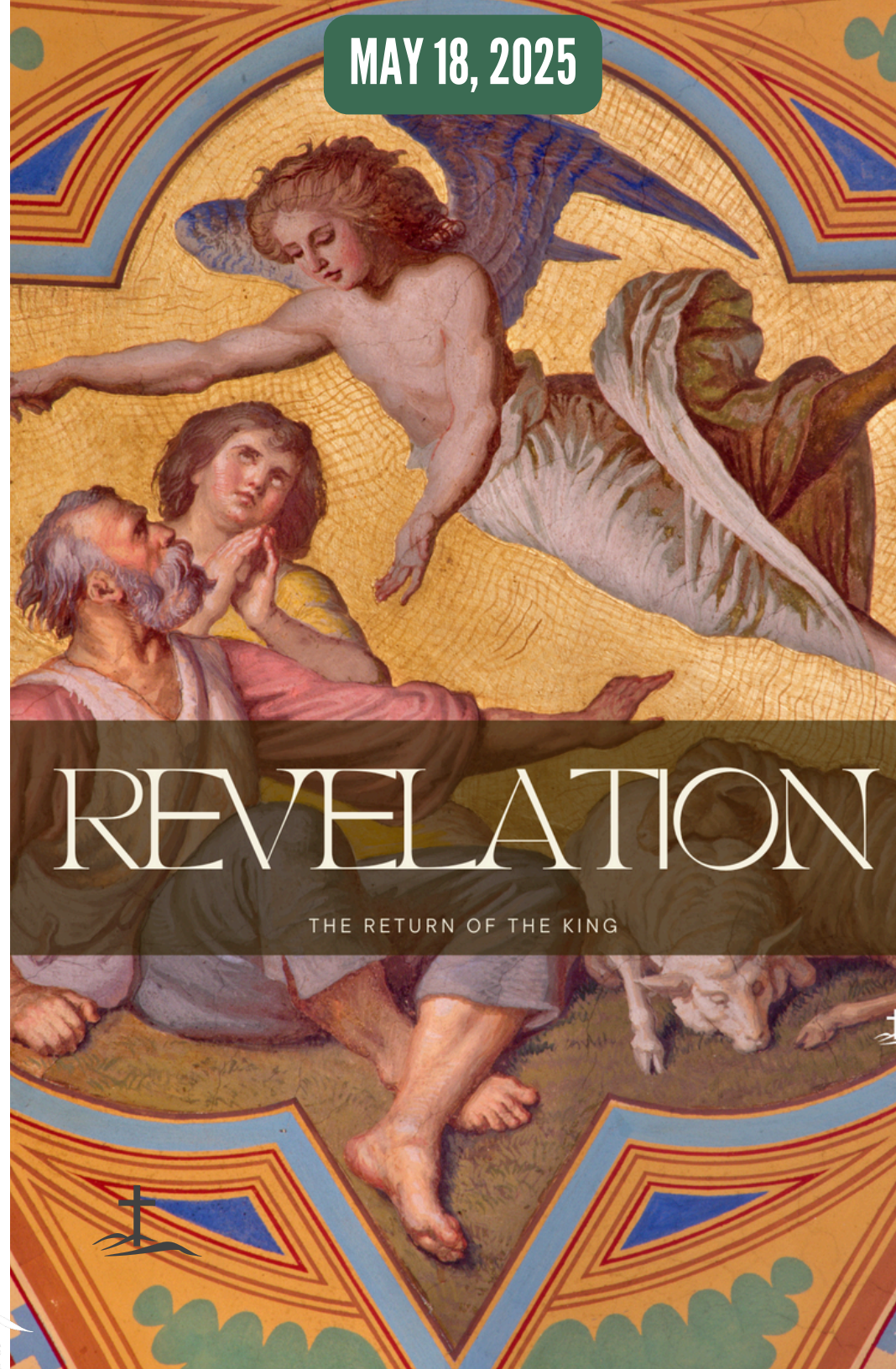

THE GOSPEL

THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

GOD: The only all-knowing, all-powerful King and Creator of all things. He created us to enjoy and glorify him forever. [Psalm 19:1-2; Romans 1:18-32]

SIN: Yet, we rejected God, and established ourselves as gods of our lives, separating ourselves from Him, and becoming objects of His wrath. In so doing we also unleashed sin, sickness, death and evil. [Ephesians 2:1-3; Romans 5:12-14]

CHRIST: In God's unparalleled mercy and grace, He already had a plan to reconcile us to Himself. The entire Old Testament points to the coming of the Messiah - revealed in the New Testament as Jesus Christ. [John 1; Ephesians 2:4-7; Romans 3:21-26]

RESPONSE: None of this is effective for us unless we respond in two ways: repent/turn from our self control and sin [Mark 1:15], and believe in the gospel [John 3:16-18]. We are then given new life in Christ, forgiven, justified, adopted into God's family, and we persevere in the faith. [1 John 1:9; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Matthew 24:13; Ephesians 4:1]

Revelation 19:11-21 | The Rider on the White Horse

1. Not Your Precious Moments Jesus [19:11-16; 4:1; 3:14; 1:13-16; John 1:1-5, 14; Revelation 1:16; Hebrews 4:12; Psalm 2:1-9; Revelation 14:19-20; Isaiah 63:3-6]

Jesus will return as a warrior.

2. Divine Trash Talking [19:17-21; Deuteronomy 28:25-26; Ezekiel 39:17-24; 1 John 5:4; 1 Corinthians 15:52-57; 2 Corinthians 5:21]

Jesus will return as a victor.

Big Idea: Because Jesus is a warrior and victor, our greatest battle has already been won.
