

THE GOSPEL

THE CENTER OF EVERYTHING WE DO AT HIGHLANDS

Deuteronomy 9:1-29 | Lessons from Family History

1. Religious Amnesia [9:1-12; Ephesians 1:11-14]

Our inheritance is based on God's grace.

2. Wedding Night Adultery [9:13-24; Exodus 32:1-6; Hebrews 7:23-25]

Our inheritance is only through Christ's intercession.

3. God's Reputation [9:25-29; Exodus 14:17-18; Ezekiel 20:13-22]

Our inheritance is ultimately for God's glory.

Big Idea: Our inheritance is from God and for God.
